Manufactured from the finest, high-gloss, and impact resistant acrylic, your Gulfstream acrylic base, and bowl, will not require heavy scrubbing. With proper care and maintenance, you will enjoy your new easy to clean pedicure unit for a lifetime!

General Cleaning Instructions & Approved Cleaners

For normal cleaning of acrylic systems use a mild non-abrasive soap and water mixture with a soft sponge or washcloth.

- Ivory Dishwashing Liquid & Water
- Formula 409
- Zep Shower & Tile
- Scrub Free w/Oxy Lemon Scent
- Bathroom Duck
- Greenworks Natural All Purpose Cleaner

Only use the approved cleaners above to clean your system. The use of unapproved cleaners and or chemicals may permanently damage your system, sealants and void your product warranty. Unfortunately, (the manufacturer) is not responsible for damage caused by chemical reaction.

The cleaning effectiveness of these products may vary depending on the type and amount of soil, water hardness, type of bath soaps used, etc. Should you choose to use a product not listed, test on a small area in the corner of the tub before applying to the entire system.

Important: When dilution is required, follow manufacturer instructions on the label. Always be sure to rinse thoroughly after cleaning. Review instructions on all cleaners before applying to your unit. Dust and dirt may be removed with a soft damp cloth.

Light Scratches / Abrasions

Light scratches can be removed and the original gloss fully restored using: Micro-Gloss, Mirror Glaze, J-Wax Turtlewax, or Kit Wax products. Do not apply wax or gloss products to the bottom of your pedicure unit.

Cleaning the Slip Resistant Bottom

As needed, scrub gently with a soft nylon brush using approved cleaners. *Do not use abrasive brushes, products or pads such as Scotch Brite®.

Unapproved Household Cleaners

Do not use the following products- Windex, Original Clean Shower, Clean Shower for Plastic Showers & Glass, Soft Scrub, Dow disinfectant cleaner, Scrub Free, Lysol disinfectant cleaner, Acetone, Lestoil, Ammonia, Nail polish remover, Aerosol cleaners, or Scouring pads. Do not expose your system to harsh chemicals such as spray-and-leave products, hair dyes, acetone (nail polish remover), nail polish, dry cleaning solution, paint removers and thinners, lime removers, drain or toilet bowl cleaners, gasoline, pine oil or strong detergents formulated for use on tile or porcelain enamel surfaces. The use of abrasive cleaners, unapproved chemicals, or scouring pads will cause discoloration and/or chemical crazing/cracking of the acrylic and sealants. Abrasive cleaners dull the gloss over a period of years. In extreme cases where the recommended cleaners do not work, use a Chore Boy or 3M Sponge pad. Make sure you only use the ones recommended for Teflon Surfaces or non-stick surfaces.



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
